## THE RED ARROW — FOUR LOCATIONS

This classic diner first opened its doors on Lowell Street in Manchester in October 1922, and at one time had six locations around the city. It closed briefly in the 1980s, but came back under new owner Carol Sheehan as fun and a little cheeky. Red Arrow fans include Adam Sandler, who has a dish named after him. Sheehan expanded locations to Nashua, Londonderry and Concord, pioneered the characters of “Dinah” and “Moe,” and introduced a fun vibe with serenading first-timers.
